No tests or new assignments of any kind are to be given on Thursday, January 9, or Friday, January 10. This time should be used to review and prepare for final exams.

If a student is late to a final exam, he/she must report to his/her principal for an admit to the test. A student will be admitted to any test within the first 15 minutes with a pass from the student's principal. No extra time will be allowed to take the exam. A student arriving after 15 minutes will be counted absent. If a student is more than 15 minutes late, he/she is considered absent. If the student's principal rules the absence excused, the student will be allowed to make up the test at a later time. If the absence is ruled unexcused, no make-up test will be allowed and the student will receive a zero on the test.

The only excuse for not being present for final exams is illness of the student or illness or death in the immediate family. If a student is absent because of illness, he or she must have a note signed by a doctor. If a doctor is not used, the parent should call the school nurse, and she will ascertain if the illness is a valid excuse for being absent from school.

Students are required to remain in classroom the entire testing period. Early dismissals are not granted on final exam days.
